Residential Sanitation Collection Changes

May 26, 2025 – Memorial Day: Monday's trash will be picked up Tuesday; Tuesday's trash will be picked up Wednesday.

June 19, 2025 - Juneteenth: The office is open. All trash will run as normal.

July 4, 2025 - Independence Day: The office is closed. All trash will run as normal.

Sept. 1, 2025 – Labor Day: Monday's trash will be picked up Tuesday; Tuesday's trash will be picked up Wednesday.

Oct. 13, 2025 – Columbus Day: Monday's trash will be picked up Tuesday; Tuesday's trash will be picked up Wednesday.

Nov. 10, 2025 – Last week for hazardous waste appts. & mulch loading.

Nov. 11, 2025 – Veterans Day: No change to trash service. All trash will run as normal.

Nov. 27, 2025 – Thanksgiving Day: Thursday's trash will be picked up Wednesday. No change in Friday's collection. (The office will be closed the 27th & 28th).

Dec. 8, 2025 – Seasonal suspension of yard waste collection. (Will resume in March)

Dec. 25, 2025 – Christmas Day: Thursday's trash will be picked up Wednesday. No change I in Friday's collection.

Jan. 1, 2026 – New Year's Day:.Thursday's trash will be picked up Wednesday. No change in Friday's collection.

The office is closed on all holidays unless otherwise noted.

*CITY-WIDE SPRING CLEAN-UP: **held the first Sat. in April every year**

The City of Rolla Environmental Services Department has an annual city-wide **RESIDENTIAL** spring clean-up. All items must be to the curb by 6:00 a.m. Loose items should be placed in boxes or bags and small pieces of lumber should be bundled or boxed. Regular *trash containers will* **NOT** *be emptied*. To avoid scavengers ripping open bags and making a mess in your yard, you are advised not to set it out until Friday evening. If you have questions about certain items, please call the Environmental Services Department at 364-6693.

<u>Examples of items that WILL be accepted are:</u> furniture, microwaves, televisions, old clothes, toys, lawn mowers, lawn furniture, and normal household trash.

<u>Items that will NOT be accepted are</u>: washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, water heater, paint & other liquids yard waste, tires, or construction debris such as sheet rock, shingles, concrete or rock.
